Charlton reported on the excellent work that Neal Olson is doing creating and welding a new structure for the Vulcan.

Neil is ahead of schedule, which possibly might reduce the overall project cost, Charlton reported.

The existing frame is being restored — sandblasted and painted — and then the task will be to return the Vulcan back to Marine Park.

Thanks to Camden Glass for constructing a glass window for the Vulcan.

The board discussed preparations for the June 4, 2022 fundraising dinner at the Masonic Hall.

Charlton will begin an invitation list.

Lynda will design a poster: “Return of the Vulcan!”

Marci will post the flyers once they are printed.

Marci will assume dessert responsibility for the dinner.

There was some discussion about coordinating with the Camden-Rockport Historical Society about helping with the Vulcan restoration.

Marci is to pursue that angle.

The board agreed to convene again April 25 and focus on two events:

Ideas to be explored April 25:

- 1) the June 4 dinner; and
- 2) The celebration at the Harbor once the Vulcan has returned.
